## Are you ready to become an assessor/inspector?

To be a FEMA disaster assessor/inspector with MCS you must:

- ✓ Have a high school diploma or GED equivalent.
- ✓ Be a U.S. citizen and have a valid driver's license.
- ✓ Be fluent in speaking, reading and comprehending English. Knowledge of or fluency in Spanish is a plus.
- ✓ Be proficient in basic math and computer skills.
- ✓ Be willing and have the flexibility to travel frequently if necessary.
- ✓ Have the desire to help others in need and make a difference along with the willingness to work in disaster-affected environments, which can be demanding and unstable.
- ✓ Complete and pass a FEMA-required background investigation, credit check, and fingerprint analysis. All candidates must have physically resided in the U.S. or a U.S. territory for at least 3 of the last 5 years at the time of the FEMA background investigation.
